The Central Branch has a wide variety of materials for genealogical research, including published histories and biographies; Federal Census records; microfilmed newspapers from around the state; birth, death, marriage, and divorce indexes; and Portland City directories.

The Forum's library has one of the largest collections of genealogical resources in the Pacific Northwest. Their holdings consist of some 20,000 books, a large assortment of microfilm and periodicals, and 50 CD-ROM databases. The Forum also offers fee-based research assistance for patrons who live outside of the Portland area. Information about this service is available on their website.
